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KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

Everything regarding this event will be held outdoors and we will be following CDC guidelines. Here are a few key points to remember:

- •PLEASE PLAN ON ARRIVING EARLIER to allow for extra safety procedure time as well as time to purchase raffle tickets! Raffle tables will be open at 11:30 am. Raffle winners will be chosen via a recorded video and items may be picked up after the tournament.
- •We will not have a sit-down reception following the tournament to maintain social distancing. Dinners will be received "to go".
- •Masks will be required when entering the facility restrooms as well as when social distancing cannot be maintained. If your team is from the same household, you do not need to wear a mask around them while golfing. If your team is not of the same household, a face mask will be required when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- •Everyone will have their temperatures checked prior to participating in the event by a StoneHedge employee.
- •There will be hand sanitizer available at several locations.
- •Golf Carts will be sanitized prior to our tournament.
- •To maintain rigorous cleaning procedures, only the restrooms at the Pavillion next to the parking lot are available for use.
- •The bar, restaurant, pro-shop, and all other indoor areas will be closed to the public.

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Remembering our little "Powerful Warrior" Liam Christopher Schulze 1.2.08 – 9.9.09

This year will be 11 years Liam has been gone. We continue to work diligently in his honor to improve the outcome for those that are faced with this journey. HLH is a very aggressive and fast acting disorder. It took my baby boy from the most beautiful blonde haired, blue-eyed, happy and active child, to a child that was unrecognizable and could not move on his own due to the aftermath of the chemotherapy and high dose steroids. HLH took everything from him and everything from us. However, Liam remained strong-willed through it all. He continued to try and flash us a smile even when

his body was failing him and had taken every bit of strength he had. He should have been diagnosed sooner, and he should still be here with us today. I continue to move forward year after year without him, trying to fundraise, help other Histio families, raise awareness, and remember and honor my precious son.

Ethan Thomas Carle "Champ" 11.18.10 – 5.9.12



In 2012, at 18 months old, Ethan very suddenly became seriously ill. Doctors in his hometown of Hanover Township, PA believed he was suffering from a viral infection but after several trips to the ER, no clear answers and being admitted to a nearby trauma hospital - the results were catastrophic...Ethan was suffering from liver failure. Despite all hope and prayers, Ethan's prognosis grew even more dire as a cause wasn't immediately found. Finally, a physician from Philadelphia was covering and had seen a similar case. Immediate testing was ordered and concluded that Ethan's liver failure was caused by HLH.

After being life-flighted to Philadelphia, Ethan began treatment with chemotherapy/steroids in preparation for a bone marrow

transplant. Ethan's battle was horrific and he suffered so much while being treated including developing a fungal infection in his blood. This proved too much for Champ to fight and on May 9th, in his parent's arms, he gained his angel wings. Ethan's parents, Tom and Lynn Carle, are devoted to ensuring other children and families do not have to suffer as Ethan and his family have. Their love for Ethan and commitment to funding research and raising awareness of HLH is what drives them to be involved in LLF.
